**The World’s Fair Bison**

A pair of bronze bison were created by Edward Kemeys as temporary sculptures for the 1893 World’s Fair and later exhibited in Garfield Park. In 1911, they were cast in bronze. No one knows why they were moved to Humboldt Park in 1915.

The male bison, “Prairie King,” gazes ahead. The female, named “Sound of the Whoop,” is grazing or listening with her head lowered.
