Museum of Science and Industry
 The Museum of Science and Industry is one of two buildings remaining from the 1893 World’s Fair, where it served as the Palace of Fine Arts.

Columns surrounding the building are designed to look like female figures. Known as caryatids, they are copied after classical forms in ancient Greece. The building’s 24 caryatids share the load of the roof with their heads, but each is slightly different.
