Casa Aztlán

Casa Aztlán was a community center serving Pilsen’s Mexican immigrant community. In 1971, community members painted a mural on the building combining traditional Mexican motifs with local elements.

After the mural was whitewashed by a developer in 2017, the original muralist, Ray Patlan, repainted it. He kept much of the initial design and added portraits of local heroes.
